

Dropbox

For a PC

- Go to www.bobspalding.net
- Select **Downloads** on left bar
- Click on DropBox
- Once downloaded to your computer, you will see it on the left bottom of your screen (**DropBoxInstaller.exe**) or in your Download Folder
- Click on the file **DropBoxInstaller.exe**
- Follow the prompts to Download and Install - it will take a few minutes or longer depending on the speed of your computer and Internet.
- Once downloaded and installed, it will display the **DropBox dialog box** - it also will take a minute or two to appear
- Click on **Sign Up** (lower left) - it is free
- You will get an email confirming you want to use Dropbox - **follow its prompts**
- Dropbox will appear in your computer as an icon (right side – at bottom)
- Once Dropbox is open you will be ready to receive or send files
 - You can create a folder or folders if needed
- To Download a file
 - Once you have Dropbox up and running, email the person
 - He or she will add you to the list
 - Then that person will return your email with a link to their Dropbox
 - Double click on the link and Dropbox will open automatically
 - If the file in their Dropbox is not too big, you should be able to open it
 - However, if the file has an **“.exe”** extension, you will have to download it to your computer before it can be opened
 - Select the file wanted, copy it and then paste it to your computer

- To Upload a file
 - Right click on the Dropbox Icon (Open [Dropbox.com](https://dropbox.com))
 - At top click on icon to Upload
 - Select file to upload

- Then send a message to the person(s) that need to download the file
