Adjustment Brush

- Right side Panel
- The Basic Panel makes Global Changes to the entire photo
- Adjustment Brush can be use to make changes to specific areas in the Photo
- It is like using the Graduated Filter and Radial Filter to a different level
- Can adjust the Brush Size
- Feathering edges – soft/hard
 - Low edges not very soft
 - High edges are softer
- It is like Dodging and Burning
- Under the Photo Pane
 - Shows an Edit Pins
 - Turn on to Auto
 - Show – shows you the mask overlay
- Can press Delete Key to remove the Brush
- Turn on Auto Mask
 - Allows you to use a bigger brush
 - Do NOT allow the “+” to go outside the area

- Local Adjustments
 - Go to Adjustment Brush
 - Reset all Sliders
 - Go to Effects
 - Double Click
 - Slide the Adjustment are wanted
 - Click on it
 - Take the Brush Took (towards the bottom)
 - Paint over the Area
