## Raw vs Jpg

- Importing
  - If you do not tell LR to import both Raw and Jpg, it will only import Raw Files
  - o If you tell LR to import both, they will be side by side
    - Do so by Edit -> Preferences -> Import Options (middle of screen)
    - Click "Treat jpgs file next to Raw files"
- One difference is in White Balance
- RAW you can change the entire WB
- Jpg, only change (As Shot/Auto/Custom)
- Another difference is under Camera Calibration
  - Set Picture Style in Camera as well as other settings
  - When you shoot jpg, those camera settings are locked into the photo
  - When shooting RAW, those camera settings are disregarded
  - In RAW, you can go into the Profile area and change them if wanted
  - In Jpg, you are not losing anything except the ability to change them
- Exposure
  - In RAW you have a much better chance of correcting over exposed photos and recovering the detail
  - o RAW photos have much more information
