Selecting Photos



At the bottom of the panel box above

- The box is the Grid Panel button
- The next box is the Screen panel button, by pressing it, this will give you an enlarge view of the photo you are looking at
 - Can go to the top of the Left Panel Navigator and change the enlargement of the photo. It is usually set as 1:1 or Fill the Screen
 - Or if you are in Grid View (G), can press the Space Bar to get an Enlarge Photo
- The XY box Compare View
 - Use this View to select one photo (best) in the entire folder.
 - o I will not use this
- Survey View
 - o Selecting the best image from a group of similar images
 - o Select the first one and then Shift Click on the last one in the group
 - o Then press Shift-Tab and all the panels go away and you are only looking at the photos
 - Move the photos around
 - Press X on the photos you do NOT want
 - You will be left with one Photo
 - Mark the photo (Flag/Color Bar/Rate)

Tagging Photos

- Go to the Photo Menu on File Menu Bar
 - o Go down to Auto Advance and turn on
 - o This will automatically take you to the next picture
- Go through all photos and place a "P" for Pick or a "X" for Reject
- Once done, go to Photo Menu
 - o Delete Rejected Photos
 - o Remove from Disk
