
iPhone Camera Grid for Composition

The Grid mode is used mainly to be sure your photo is straight and to practice good composition.

This Grid looks like a Tic-Tac-Toe screen.



The Grid is also called the "Rule of Thirds". The rule says that it is better to place your subject off-center rather than in the middle of the photo. The idea is to place your main subject at the intersection of one of the lines.

To turn the Grid on; Go to Settings -> Camera -> Grid
