

Tips on Taking Action Shots with the iPhone

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An Action photograph is a photo showing some type of action: a dog jumping, someone running in a sporting event, a child playing, etc. In order to capture an action picture(s) on the iPhone, you need to use the Burst Mode. This will allow the user to take multiple high-speed photos so that you have a range of photos to choose from. According to Apple iPhone User Guide, this is how to use the Burst Mode:

1. Open Camera.
 2. Do one of the following:
 - *On iPhone XS, iPhone XR, and later models:* Swipe the Shutter button to the left.
 - *On iPhone X and earlier models:* Touch and hold the Shutter button.
- The counter shows how many shots you've taken.
 - Lift your finger to stop.
 - To select the photos you want to keep, tap the Burst thumbnail at the bottom, then tap Select.
 - Gray dots below the thumbnails mark the suggested photos to keep.
 - Tap the circle in the lower-right corner of each photo you want to save as an individual photo, then tap Done.
 - To delete the entire Burst, tap the thumbnail, then tap  .
